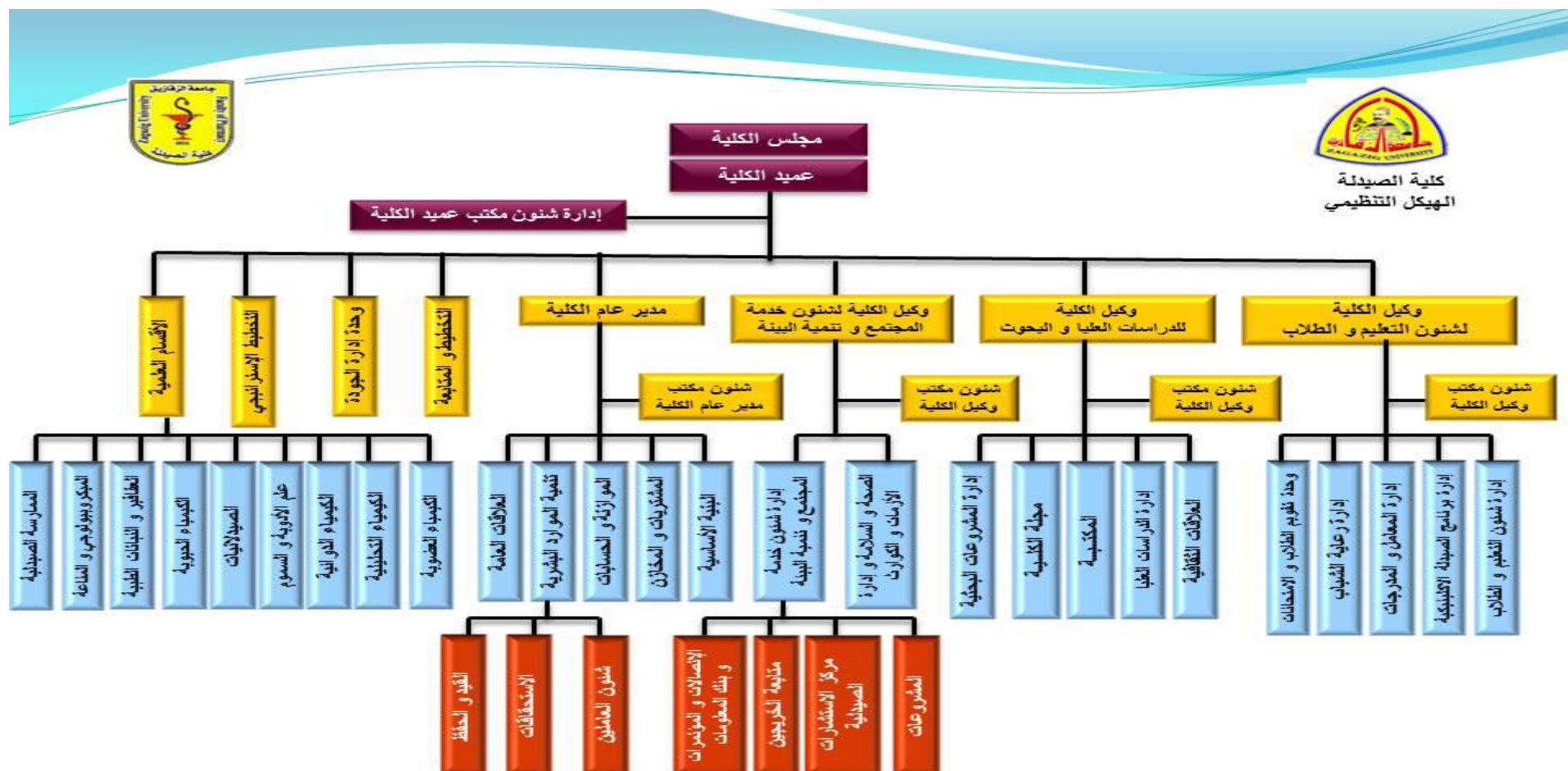

4. Strategic planning:

Strategic planning unit was established in September 2017. Faculty of Pharmacy has prepared a strategic plan 2017 – 2022. The strategic plan is based on 7 strategic goals and 25 strategic objectives that include:

- ✓ Renovation of organic chemistry labs and toilets with a cost of 350,000 pounds.
- ✓ Air conditioning of the exam control rooms (5 air conditions).
- ✓ Renovation of the animal house with the addition of 2 new air conditioners
- ✓ Repairing all wireless audio devices at a cost of 14900 pounds.
- ✓ Start of the construction of a panoramic elevator in the labs building with a cost of 450 thousand pounds
- ✓ Purchasing a photocopier (the Ministry of Military Production -Benha for Electronic Industries) at a cost of 65,000 pounds and 15,000 pounds to buy 4 data show devices.
- ✓ Purchasing of microscopes for microbiology department with a cost of 250,000 pounds
- ✓ Purchase of a Molecular modelling software license and (3) computers.
- ✓ 99, 691, 25 pounds for maintenance of the public high plate and sub-cables feeder for the laboratory buildings in the faculty.
- ✓ 30,000 pounds for fixing an iron fence on the roof of the administrative building for students safety.

- ✓ 279,645 pounds for the maintenance of electrical panels in the laboratories building.
- ✓ Installation of 11 cameras on the entrances of the faculty and 2 cameras for the exam control rooms.

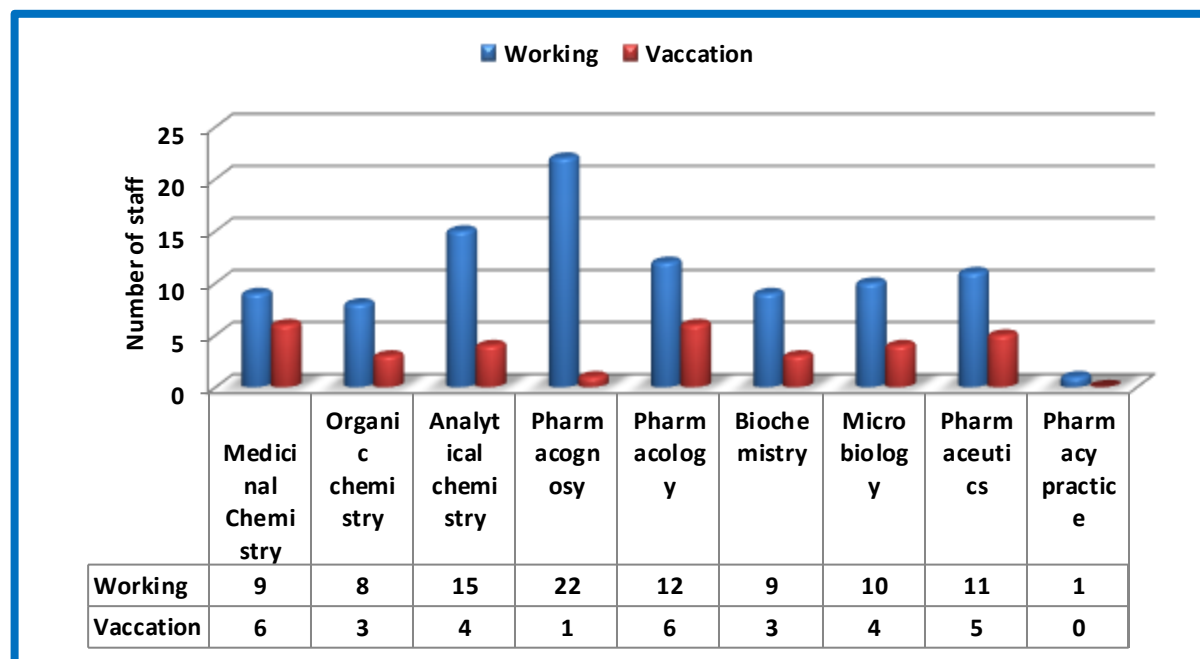


Figure 2. Number of teaching staffs in different faculty departments.

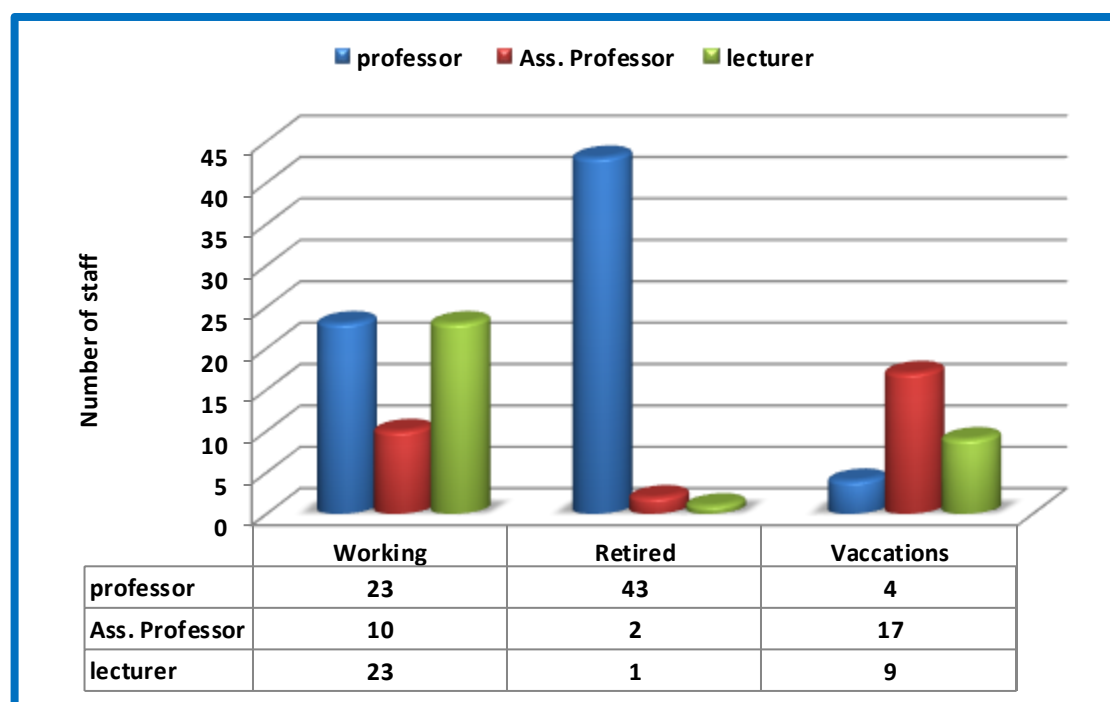


Figure 3. Classification of teaching staffs.

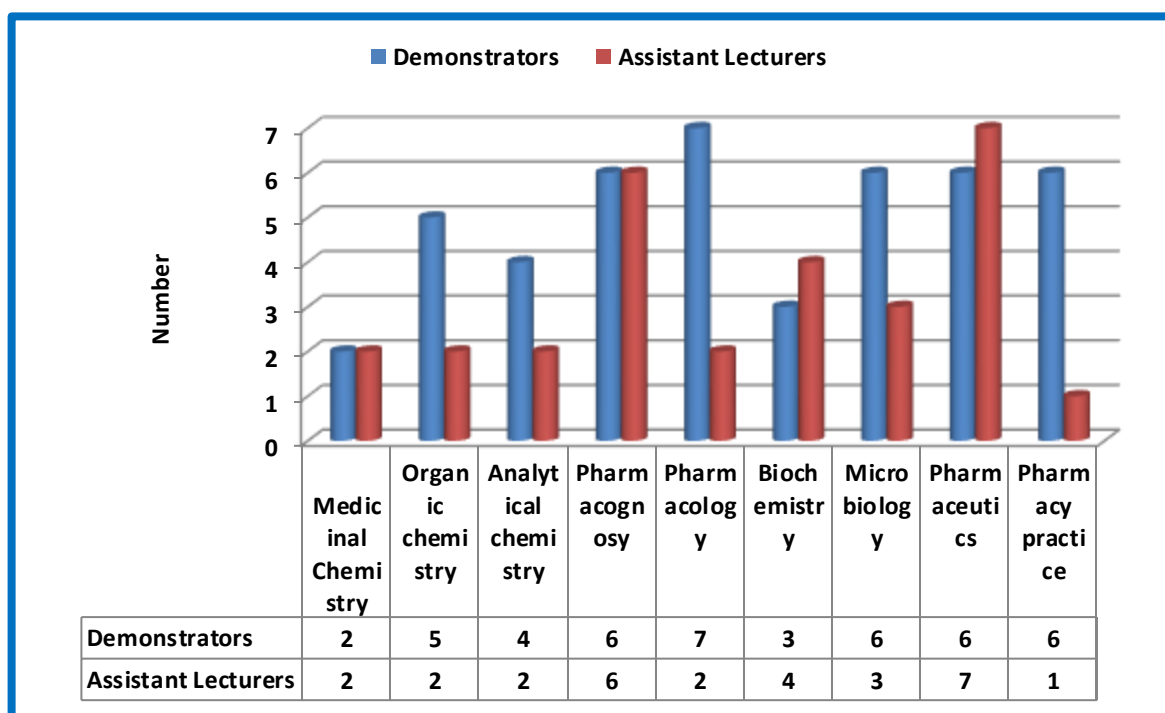


Figure 4. Number of demonstrators & assistant lecturers in different faculty departments.

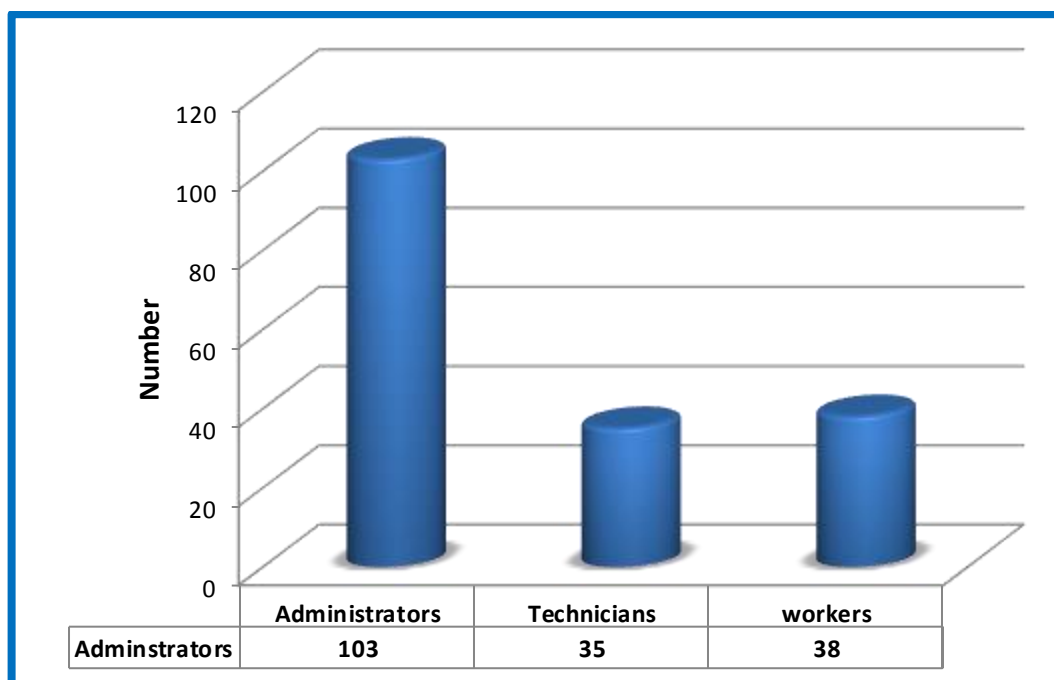


Figure 5. Number of administrators and their classification.

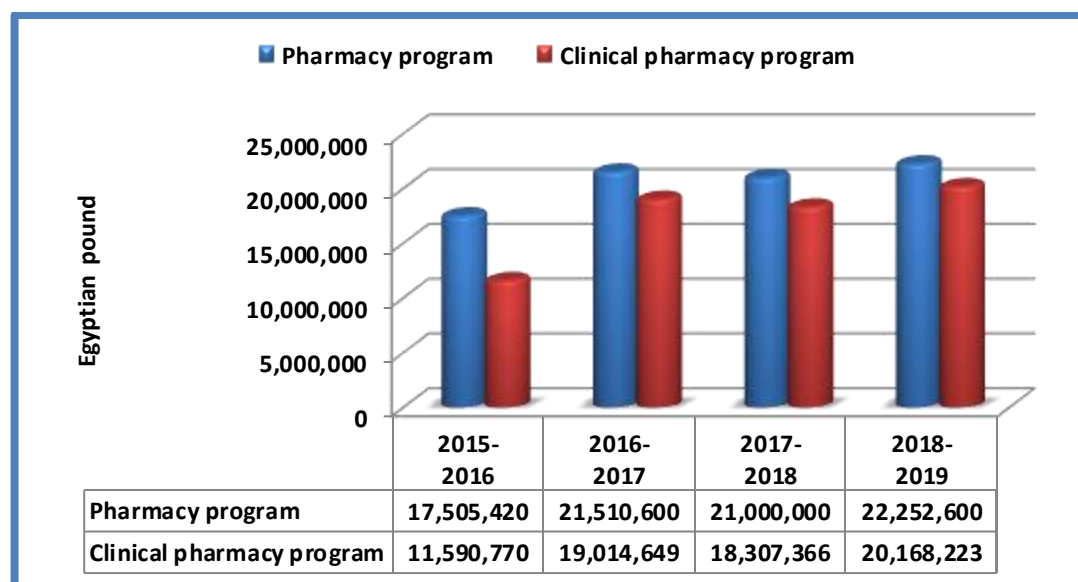


Figure 6. Faculty of Pharmacy budget within 3 academic years (2015 – 2019).

9. Academic standards and educational programs:

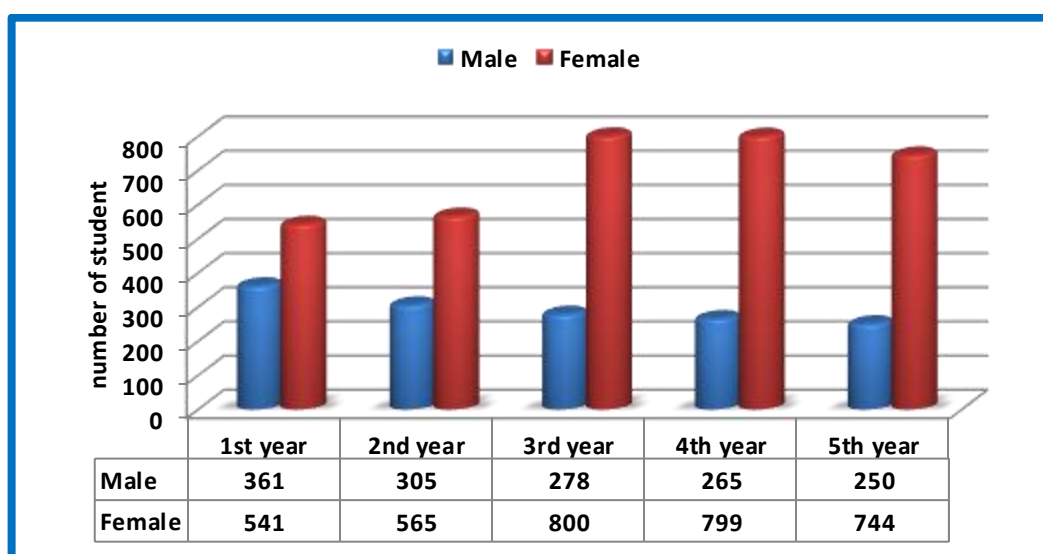
Faculty of Pharmacy programs for undergraduate and postgraduate students are based on the national academic standards published by NAQAAE, 2009. There is a plan to prepare and implement PharmD programs according to the new academic standards for pharmacy education, 2017 by the academic year 2019-2020. Accordingly, the programs will be competency based to develop 12 competencies in 4 domains necessary for the pharmacy profession: fundamental knowledge, professional & ethical practice, pharmaceutical care and personal practice. This will necessitate to add some new courses related to pharmacy practice such as Pharmacovigilance, Bioinformatics and shift in our teaching from passive into interactive learning.

Faculty of Pharmacy offers both undergraduate and postgraduate programs as illustrated in the following table:

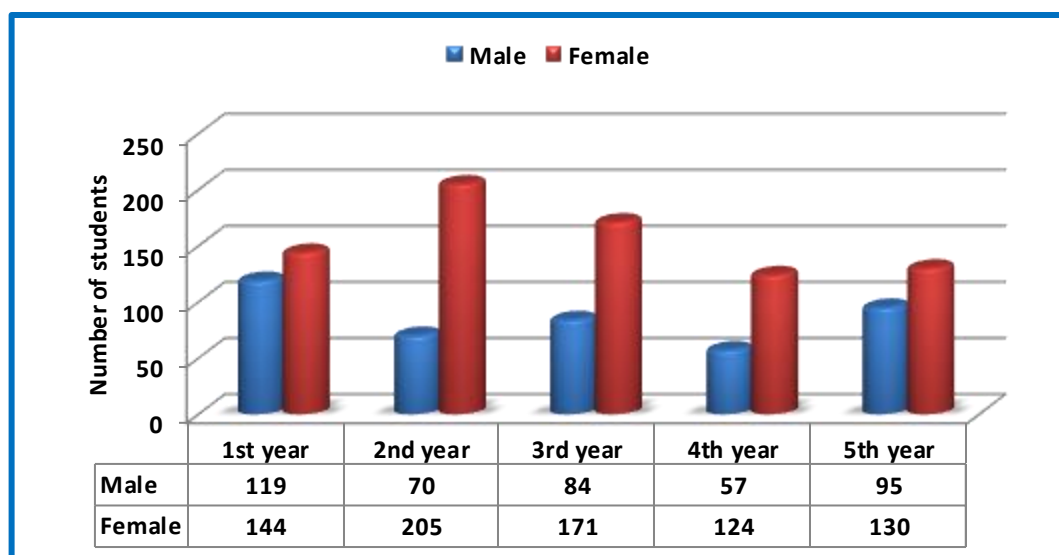

(Bachelor of pharmacy, clinical pharmacy)**

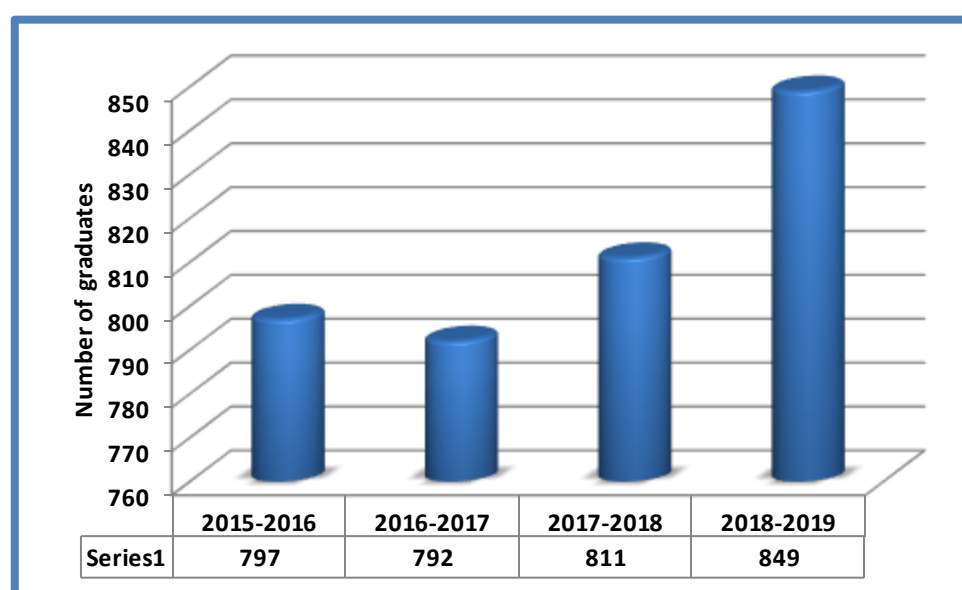


Figure 9. Statistics of graduates in the last three years (Bachelor of pharmacy).

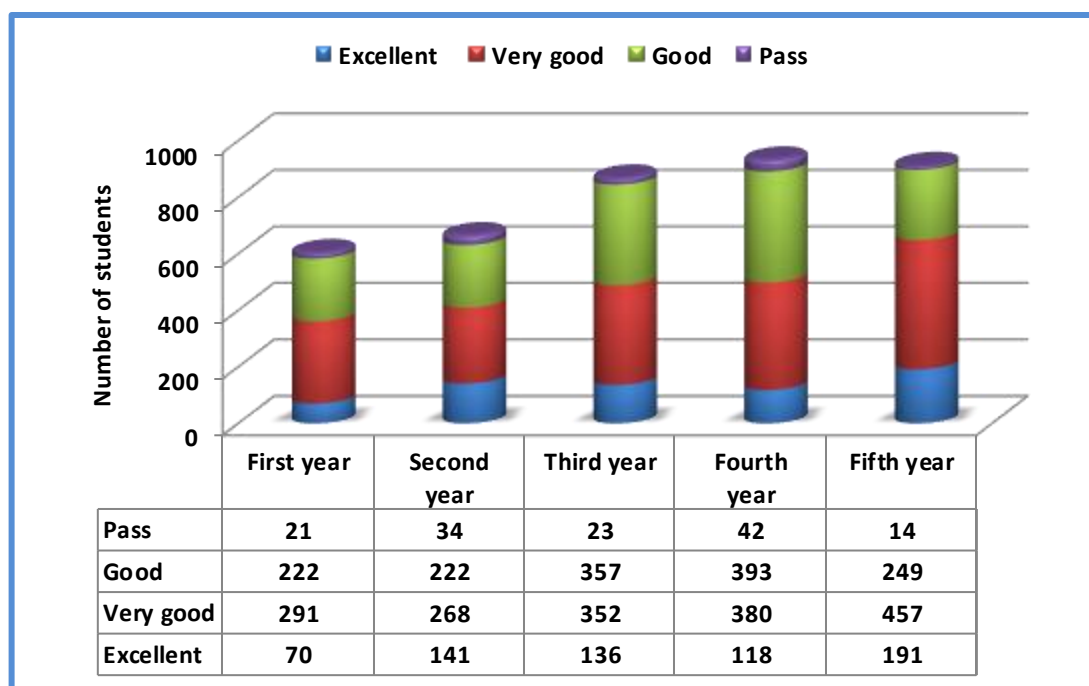


Figure 10. Statistics of students grades in different levels (Bachelor of pharmacy).

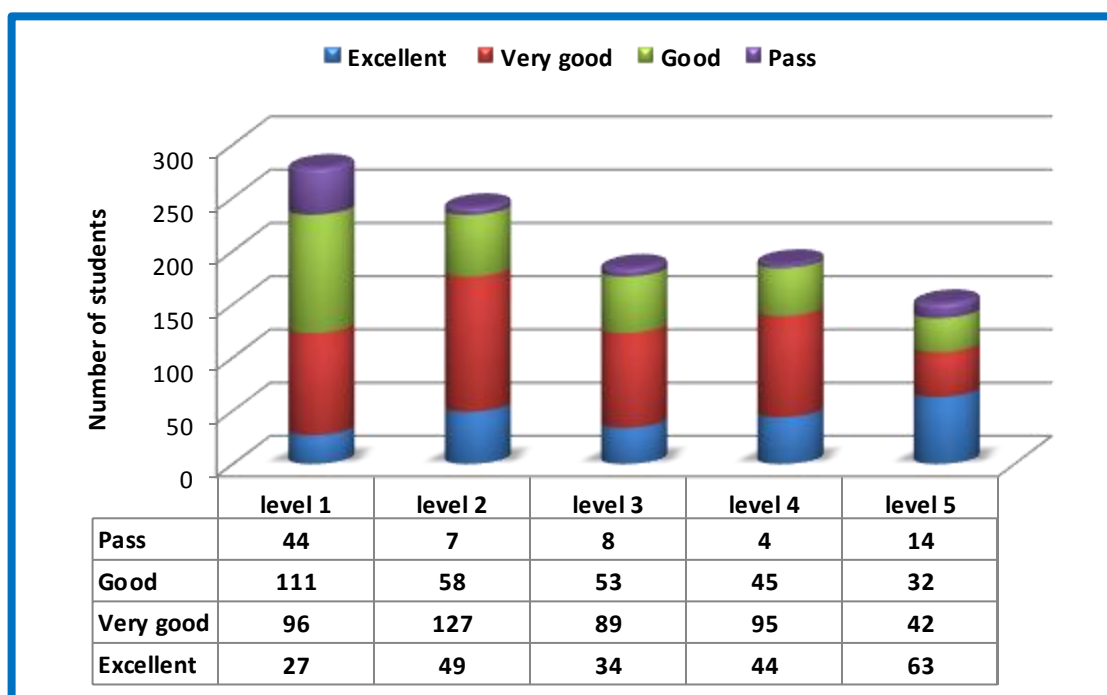


Figure 11. Statistics of students grades in different levels (Bachelor of pharmacy, Clinical Pharmacy).

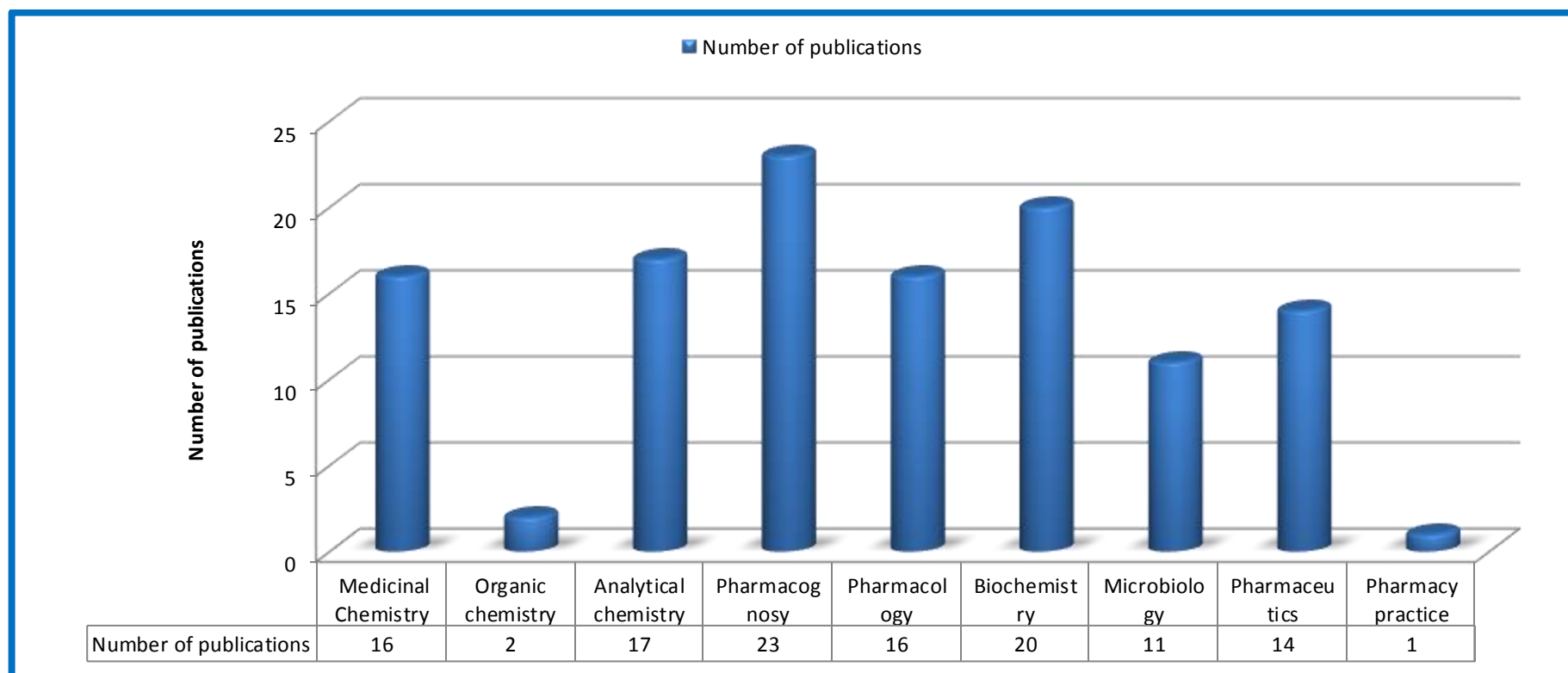


Figure 12: Distribution of publication activity between different departments in Faculty of Pharmacy.

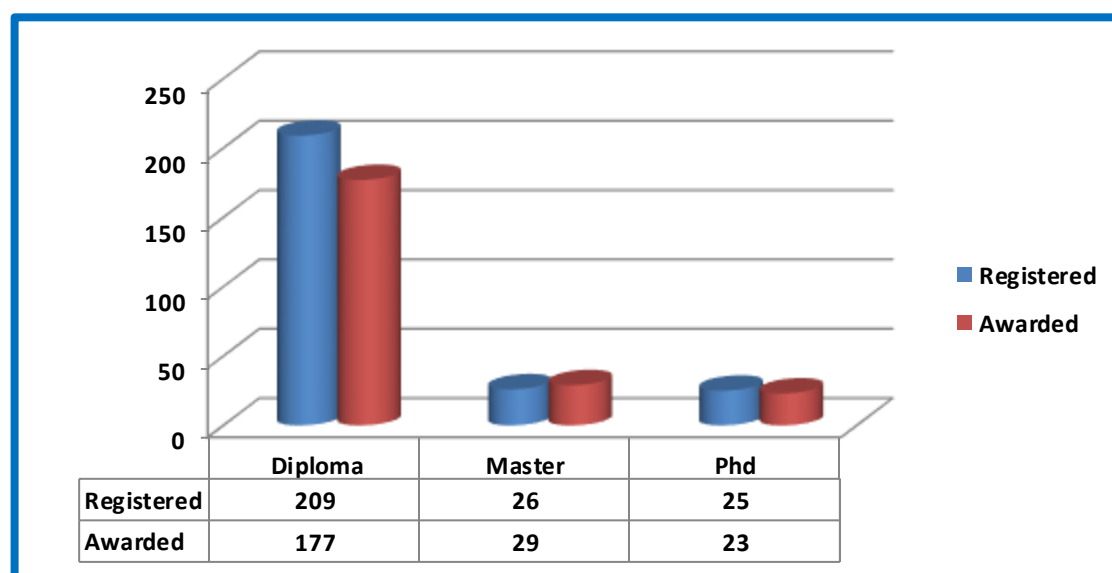


Figure 13: Number of registered students and awarded different postgraduate degrees including clinical pharmacy diploma, master and PhD degrees.

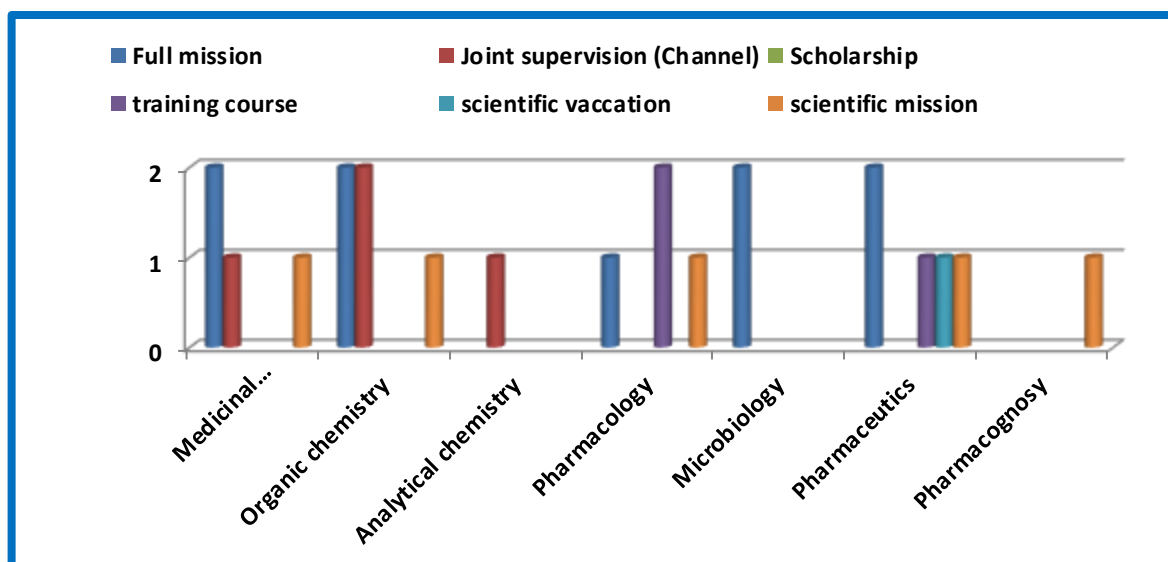


Figure 15: Number and distribution of postgraduate students in scholarships.

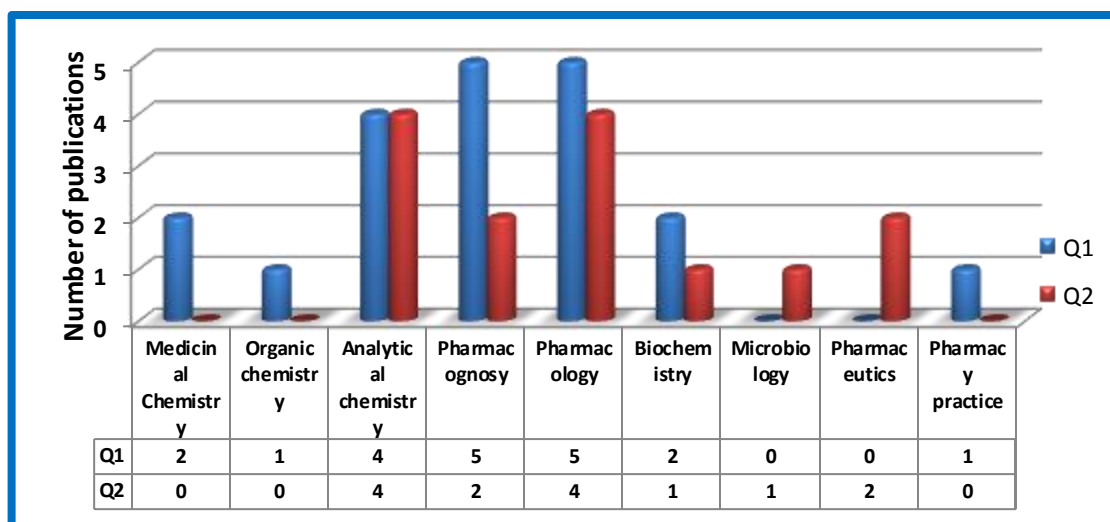


Figure 15: Distribution of international publication rewards among different departments.
