




#### **Quality of learning opportunities**

#### 5-Quality of Teaching and Learning:

The quality of teaching and learning was evaluated at the end of each semester through questionnaires directed to students. The results of these questionnaires mostly showed a high degree of satisfaction in Therapeutic and Hospital microbiology courses. On the other hand, the students complained from the condensed content in Clinical Laboratory Tests and Nutrition & anemia which is inconsistent with the short contact hours of

theory part (1 contact hour). The students were highly unsatisfied (> 70%) about Cardiovascular evaluation course.

The survey was designed to measure students satisfaction about three areas namely: overall quality of learning, adequacy of learning facilities and availability of support. In addition the overall satisfaction about the program was measured.


