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EDUCTIONAL GOALS AND OBJECTIVE

Forensic Medicine:-

The main goal of forensic medicine course is to build the competencies of the undergraduate medical students to manage the medico- legal Problems and situations that face them after graduation during the medical general practice.

Course Objectives:-

On completion of course the student will be expected to Know:

- 1. The medical ethics.
- 2. The common medico-legal aspects in different medical branches.
- 3. The relationship between the doctor and law.
- How to write a medico –legal report in Arabic as well as birth and deat certificates.
- 5. Methods of identification of age, sex, race, etc. of a person either living or dead.
- 6. How to-diagnose death and differentiate between natural and unnatural death.
- 7. How to diagnose death and different types of injuries e.g. wounds, thermal injurie firearms and explosion injuries, road traffic accidental injuries and the period needed for each type to heat.
- 8. How to differentiate between suicidal, accidental or homicidal injuries.
- 9. How to identify the victim and the assailant.
- 10. How to diagnose cases of violent asphyxia.
- 11. The injuries of violence and neglect especially in children.
- 12. How to recognize blood stain and differentiate it from other stains.
- 13.Identify the medico legal importance of blood groups.
- 14. How to solve the problem of disputed paternity.
- 15. How to manage cases of rape or other sexual assaults.
- 16. The medico legal aspects of virginity, pregnancy, delivery and abortion

Clinical Toxicology:

The main goal of the course of toxicology is to build the competencies of the undergraduate medical student to diagnose and manage the cases of poisoning that will face them after graduation during the medical general practice.

Course objectives:-

On completion of the course the student will be expected to know:

- 1. Definition of poisoning and factors affecting it.
- 2. The general management of poisoned patient.
- 3. How to manage the cases of corrosive poisoning.
- 4. How to manage the cases of different plant poisoning.
- 5. How to manage the cases of heavy metal poisoning.
- 6. How to manage the cases of volatile and gaseous poisoning.
- 7. How to manage the cases of insecticides poisoning.
- 8. How to manage the cases of therapeutic agents poisoning.
- 9. How to manage the cases of drug abuse.
- 10. How to manage the cases of poisoning due to animal bites.
- 11. How to manage the cases of food poisoning.
