7- Original birth certificate.

8- A declaration that he will not enroll (enrolled) in postgraduate studies in any other college or university.

Conditions for admission and enrollment to the master's degree

1- He must have a bachelor's degree in physical education with a general grade of at least good (before modification) and an acceptable grade (after modification) from an Egyptian university or an equivalent degree from a scientific institute or recognized college, provided that it has not been more than a year since he obtained his degree. Bachelor's degree more than (8) years old. This requirement excludes applicants from outside the Arab Republic of Egypt (expatriates), or must have held a postgraduate diploma in physical education with a general grade of at least good, and no more than two years have passed since obtaining the diploma.

2- At least two years have passed since his graduation, and one year for repeat students and expatriates.

3- Applicants will be differentiated upon announcement based on the numbers required and proposed by the relevant department councils and the approval of the College Council in light of the available capabilities.
