Overview of the College About the College

The Faculty of Veterinary Medicine was established in 1969 and was then affiliated with Ain Shams University until Zagazig University was established in 1974 and became one of its faculties, and the college serves the students of Sharkia Governorate and neighboring governorates .

Thousands of veterinarians have graduated from it, and it still provides the veterinary medicine sector in Egypt and the Arab world with competent veterinarians whose mission is to protect livestock, poultry, wildlife and human food security .

The college is located in the southeastern part of the city of Zagazig on an area of 13 acres and has an extension in the Khattara area about 100 acres (one hundred acres).

The college ranks first in Africa, Arab and local, and 61st globally in all indicators of the Spanish Simago International Ranking for 2024.

The college has been accredited by the National Authority for Quality Assurance and Accreditation since 2015, and the accreditation was renewed in 2023

College's Service Units

College farm

(educational / research / production) was established in 1984 and aims to carry out an educational and research mission for undergraduate and graduate students and serve the community and the environment. One of its achievements is that it provides animals to teach students in the college courses, provides animal blood samples, provides poultry in poultry diseases for graduate students, conducts special research for animal and poultry nutrition and also for graduate students, in addition to summer training for students on animal and poultry breeding, care and treatment systems and farm management systems, in addition to providing productive services to college and university employees and the surrounding environment by providing red and white meat and dairy at appropriate prices (cooperative prices).

Veterinary hospital

A modern educational unit established by the university president's decision No. 236 of 1977, and the hospital contains many units:

Importance of Veterinary Hospital

- 1 - The hospital plays an effective role in helping the college to fulfill its educational mission and provide its services to the surrounding environment.
- 2 - Treatment and prevention of animals and poultry and conducting the necessary analyzes for various diseases.
- 3 - Activating the role of veterinary guidance to raise productive efficiency through caravans, seminars and publications
- 4- Developing the college's resources and providing distinguished services and a leading role in community service and environmental development.
- 5 - Using the latest diagnostic methods (ultrasound).
- 6- Providing researchers with experimental animals through the experimental animal unit at the hospital .

Central Laboratory

The central laboratory is a unit of a special nature with technical, financial and administrative independence and is considered an educational, service and research unit and was established in 1997 in accordance with the decision of the Supreme Council of Universities No. 228 and the central laboratory has many modern devices that are used in various analyzes and has a microscope for imaging and examination.

The laboratory aims to provide research services to researchers at the university, other universities and research centers by conducting various laboratory analyzes with the latest equipment, providing services to educators, farmers, farms and production projects by conducting various laboratory analyzes.

The center conducts training courses and seminars for researchers, technicians and workers in the field of animal, poultry and fish production and participates in the summer training of



undergraduate students at the college by training them on the latest scientific equipment in the field of veterinary analysis.

Quality Management Unit (QMU)

Introduction :

Talking about the process of quality development in any organization means talking about providing a distinctive service in form, content, content and method of performance in order to achieve the satisfaction of the beneficiaries. From this point of view, and with the desire to raise the level of academic performance and develop the level of service provided to students and academic staff, the college established the Quality Unit .

Since its inception, the Quality Unit has set out to develop performance in all aspects of academic work in the college, and has been able, by the grace of God, to put itself on the right path towards developing the academic performance to which the college aspires, and the unit decided to expand its field of activity to include the administrative and service aspects of the college, in an effort to improve all aspects of performance in the college .

Scientific magazine

It is a scientific journal that specializes in publishing scientific research in the field of veterinary medical sciences and related sciences such as (agricultural sciences / human medicine / dentistry / pharmacy / science) and is issued by the Faculty of Veterinary Medicine at Zagazig University in the form of quarterly periodic issues. A copy of the magazine is sent to the faculty members of the faculty and the relevant university faculties - faculties of veterinary medicine in Egyptian universities - specialized research institutes and laboratories - the General Authority for Veterinary Services - the Academy of Scientific Research and Technology - the Library of Alexandria - the Central Library.

Enrollment and College Transfer Policy

The Faculty of Veterinary Medicine at Zagazig University follows the admission and transfer policies stipulated in the Egyptian Universities Organization Law and its executive regulations (Law 49 of 1979) and the decisions of the Supreme Council of Universities in this regard .

First, the number of students the college accepts each year: -

The Higher Council of Universities determines at the end of each academic year, based on a proposal from the University Council after taking the opinion of the Faculty Council, the number of students who will be admitted to the Faculty of Veterinary Medicine at Zagazig University in the following year.

II: Who is eligible to apply for the program

1- Holders of a high school diploma (science division) from the Arab Republic of Egypt.



2- Holders of an equivalent certificate for the Egyptian high school, science division (expatriates).

The paperwork required to enroll in college for Egyptian freshmen:

- 1- High school certificate form + a photocopy of it.
- 2- Nomination card
- 3- Birth certificate (with the triple number for males) + a photocopy of it.
- 4- 6 personal photos
- 6- Medical examination form printed from the online registration website.
- 6- Form 2 male soldier for males
- 7- A copy of the student's national ID card + a copy of the parent's national ID card

Documents required for students who obtained their high school diploma from outside Egypt (expatriates):

* The student applies to the General Directorate of Expatriates of the Ministry of Higher Education (registration on the Study in Egypt platform) with the following papers:

- 1- The high school certificate (equivalent) certified and legalized by the Embassy of the Arab Republic of Egypt from the countries from which the student obtained the high school, or from the country's embassy in Cairo.
- 2- Original birth certificate or an official extract from it.
- 3- A number (6) recent photographs.
- 4- Fulfillment of the data of the following papers and found inside an envelope obtained from the Embassy in Cairo and the Arab Affairs Office

The envelope contains:

- (Application for enrollment (Form 555 Coordination))
- Initial nomination card
- Information form (4 copies)
- Parental Declaration

* After the student is notified of his/her candidacy to join the college, the student must go to the college's Student Affairs Office to complete the aforementioned application procedures.

Transfers

First: Transfers of students of the higher teams (second and third):

Transfer students can transfer to equivalent colleges in other universities under the following conditions:

- 1- The transfer between equivalent colleges in universities should be centralized at the level of each university.
- 2- The student must be successful and transferred to a higher division in the transferred college.
- 3- The percentage of transfers does not exceed 10% of the number of students enrolled in the division to which the transfer is requested.
- 4- Priority for transfer among applicants should be for students with the highest totals.
- 5- It is not permissible to accept requests to transfer students between analogous colleges after one month after the start of the study.

Conversion method:

The student submits the transfer request with a status statement extracted from the college to the Central Student Affairs Office.

Paperwork required for transfer:

- 1- Transfer request.
- 2- A statement of status
- 3- Proof of residence in the governorate to be transferred to.
- 4- A copy of the high school form.
- 5- Transfer file from the Central Administration of Education and Student Affairs at the university.



Note:

*Fourth and final semester students are not allowed to transfer

*-Transfers are centralized through the university and according to the decision of the University Council for transfers in each year in accordance with the University Organization Law and the organizing regulations.

I: Bachelor of Veterinary Medicine General Program Credit Hours

Objectives and importance of the program :

The program aims to achieve the following objectives :

- Prepare veterinarians who, upon graduation, are able to meet the basic needs of society and prepare for potential changes, whether regional or global.
- Prepare veterinarians who are able to establish and manage private veterinary projects without relying on government work.
- Preparing veterinarians capable of working in Arab and African countries.



- Developing scientific research to reach the highest productivity of animals with good health and disease prevention.
- Developing means of diagnosing animal, bird and fish diseases, predicting imported diseases and detecting contaminants in foods of animal origin

The program qualifies graduates to work in the following fields:

- Livestock care and development.
- Diagnosis and treatment of diseases of animals, birds and fish.
- Preventive veterinary medicine
- Public health and protection of humans from diseases and harmful residues that are transmitted to them from animals, products and animal waste.
- Health control and safety of food of animal origin
- Protection of the environment and wildlife.
- Veterinary pharmaceutical industry and pharmaceutical marketing.
- Manufacture of animal products and waste recycling.
- Specialized veterinary consultations and feasibility studies for livestock projects.

Study system:

The study period for obtaining a bachelor's degree in veterinary medicine is six years, with five academic years followed by a year of training (internship), and the academic years are represented by five study levels, each study level includes two basic semesters, and the study is divided into 3 stages- :

- 1- The academic and pre-clinical stage, which includes the first, second and third levels.
- 2- The clinical stage includes the fourth and fifth levels.
- 3- The training phase (internship), which lasts for one academic year.

1-New Programs (with expenses)

The importance and features of the new programs :

The study in the faculties of veterinary medicine is considered one of the most important studies in the medical sector due to the different types, species and breeds of animals that are studied such as farm, domestic, wild or experimental animals in addition to poultry, fish and others and the difference of each species from the other in the anatomical and physiological character, the method of treatment and the types of diseases that may affect it and methods of diagnosis and treatment. The graduate of these colleges is characterized by the lack of a specific and clear distinction for him in the labor market, as he is familiar with all branches of veterinary medicine with which he can compete in the labor market in Egypt, so to solve this issue must search for a clear distinction for the graduate of this college in line with the requirements of the real labor market and this will only be by creating new programs in these colleges that stem from the needs of the actual labor market in Egypt and the Arab countries. Therefore, the Faculty of Veterinary Medicine at Zagazig University sought to create these programs .

2-Poultry Medicine Program

Objectives of the program :

- This program aims to achieve the following objectives:



- Building an advanced educational system in line with modern trends and international systems.
- Preparing specialized cadres of veterinarians in the field of poultry medicine, developing their abilities to use modern technology and qualifying them in line with the needs of the local and regional labor market in the following areas:
 - Poultry care and breeding.
 - Diagnosis, treatment and prevention of poultry diseases (individuals - groups) using modern techniques.
 - Preparation, manufacture and control of vaccines, serums and veterinary preparations in the field of poultry.
 - Using radiology, endoscopy and ultrasound to diagnose poultry diseases.
 - Using artificial insemination technology in the poultry field.
 - Health control on slaughterhouses and factories processing meat and poultry products.
 - The use of technology in the process of recycling farm and slaughterhouse waste.
 - Using modern techniques in laboratory diagnosis of all poultry diseases.
 - Good handling of bird epidemics, veterinary quarantine and disaster response in the field of poultry.
 - Studying the economic aspects and feasibility studies for poultry projects.
 - Advertising and marketing of poultry products and preparations for diagnosis and treatment.
 - Manufacture and analysis of feeds and health control of their quality.
 - Taxidermy for educational and other purposes.
 - Familiarization with all aspects of health control of poultry meat and poultry products.

2-Veterinary Clinical Pharmacology Excellence Program

It is a distinguished program in veterinary clinical pharmacology that gives the veterinarian many skills to work in the field of veterinary clinical pharmacology in terms of prescribing the appropriate drug for the disease condition as well as the use of those drugs, feed additives and vaccines used in various poultry and animal diseases, so the distinguished veterinarian becomes one of the main pillars in specialized bodies in veterinary pharmaceuticals and scientific offices of companies and veterinary pharmaceutical factories that need to prepare veterinary drug files for registration stages, write medical bulletins and study the effectiveness of medicines.

In pharmaceutical companies, skilled veterinarians provide veterinary medical information from animal anatomy and physiology to assist pharmaceutical colleagues in the preparation, production and marketing of pharmaceutical forms needed by poultry and various animals such as feed additives, vaccines and



extended-release boluses, as well as the ability of that graduate to measure the effectiveness of these veterinary clinical pharmacology in the veterinary field.

Program message:

Preparing graduates who are knowledgeable in all veterinary medical sciences and specialized in the field of veterinary clinical pharmacology and have acquired many intellectual, professional and transferable knowledge and skills that enable them to compete strongly in the labor market.

Objectives of the program:

Creating a clear specialization for the graduate of the Faculty of Veterinary Medicine in line with the requirements of the real labor market in Egypt by developing a distinguished program in veterinary clinical pharmacology through which the graduate acquires various knowledge and skills that qualify him for real competition in the labor market.

The educational outcomes targeted by the program:

- Diagnose diseases that affect animals in a proper manner and using different methods of diagnosis - such as laboratory examination, ultrasound and radiography, as well as familiarity with common diseases between humans and animals and methods of prevention and treatment.
- Identify, evaluate and correct the nutritional status of different farm animals and provide guidance to the breeder - the principles of proper breeding and nutrition for animals.
- Developing knowledge, skills, self-education and teamwork through a team in order to qualify - to practice the profession of veterinary medicine and work to employ it to serve society and the environment through his understanding, knowledge and application of all veterinary courses that qualify him for this.
- Evaluate various veterinary medicines and ensure their sources, storage, dispensing and prescribing methods in accordance with the relevant laws and regulations.
- Apply methods of measuring and standardizing the concentration of veterinary drugs in different tissues of animals to determine the withdrawal period from cases as well as knowledge of methods of measuring the effectiveness of veterinary drugs__ Assessing the health risks associated with the indiscriminate use of veterinary drugs and familiarity with methods of detecting pharmaceutical residues in food products of animal origin.



- Avoiding the occurrence of drug interactions as well as interactions between veterinary drugs and food and how to overcome this.
- Familiarity with all that is new in the field of veterinary medicines, such as the use of stem cells to treat some diseases in animals, as well as the use of nanotechnology to improve the kinetic pathway of drugs and increase their effectiveness to facilitate their use when conditions allow.
- Become familiar with the different pharmaceutical forms of veterinary drugs, feed additives and disinfectants used on farms.
- Acquire knowledge and skills in the treatment of various medicinal plants as a complement to the chemical treatment of animals and know the active substances in them and the conditions they can treat.
- Be familiar with the proper ways to ensure the health and safety of meat, dairy, and products of animal origin.
- Correct understanding of how to minimize the risks of contamination, infection and accumulation of germs in veterinary buildings and farms, and familiarity with methods of safe disposal of the carcass after death, euthanasia, and pre- and post-mortem examination.

3-Pet Medicine and Care Excellence Program

Importance of the program:

- Due to the increasing interest in pets (cats and dogs) in recent years, in addition to the cohabitation and human contact with these animals, as many families like to raise cats and dogs in their homes for the purpose of guarding or entertainment.
- Whereas there are many dangerous diseases that may be transmitted to humans from these animals, such as Toxoplasma disease, which causes miscarriage in the first months of pregnancy, in addition to viral diseases, the most important of which is rabies, which may lead the life of the patient to death, smallpox and some other skin diseases, in addition to rodent disease that leads to hair loss, as well as parasitic diseases such as hydatidosis and migratory larvae of cat and dog ascarids, as well as worms that cause intestinal disorders, diarrhea and general weakness

- 4- He should not have ended his stay in the university city for non-payment of fees or exceeding the period of absence stipulated in Article (21) of the University Cities Regulations.
- 5- He must be medically fit and has no previous dues or debts to the cities.
- 6- The student should not be married.
- 7- The application is done through the website of the University Cities - Zagazig University.

Prosthetic devices for people with special needs:

- 1- The student must go to the Youth Welfare Office during the first month of the beginning of the study to fill out the application for obtaining a prosthetic device.
- 2- The student signs the application from the Student Affairs Department and is approved by the college administration.



3- The student submits the application to the Social Solidarity Fund Department at the university, accompanied by a medical report from the medical committee at Sidnawi Hospital.

4- The applications are presented to the competent committee after collecting them to determine the student's eligibility to obtain a prosthetic device.

5- Applicants are notified of the result of the examination and the direction to obtain the prosthetic device from the university or not.

Scientific and Technological Activity Committee :

The Scientific and Technological Activity Committee is responsible for organizing activities aimed at raising skills and supporting scientific activities among students by holding scientific seminars and lectures, spreading the culture of technology and software, its use and production, and specializing in holding scientific seminars and scientific lectures with the aim of developing scientific and technological capabilities and spreading knowledge in production and application through science clubs and scientific societies.

Federal Commissions and their activities

Student Union :

Student unions are formed from regular students of colleges and university institutes who are enrolled in them to obtain a bachelor's or bachelor's degree and who pay the union fees.

Affiliated students who pay the union fees do not have the right to vote or nominate, and they have the right to exercise the aspects of activity related to the federal committees.

Steps to join to student union membership:

- 1- Go to the Youth Welfare Office to receive the nomination application and the survey form.
- 2- After completing all the data, return the application to the Youth Welfare before the end of the time announced by the administration.
- 3- The examination committee will examine the submitted applications and determine those who meet the conditions of acceptance and exclude those who do not.
- 4- The names of the candidates who met the conditions of admission are announced, and those who did not find their names among them despite meeting the conditions have the right to submit an appeal to the college appeals committee with documents that support their position, and they have the right to submit an appeal to the university appeals committee.
- 5- The final names are announced according to what is stated in the election schedule, and there is no right to appeal after the announcement of the final lists.
- 6- Elections are held and the results of the counting are announced at the specified time.
- 7- Elections for the Faculty Student Union Council of secretaries and assistant secretaries of the committees are held to determine the position of the Secretary of the Union and the Assistant Secretary of the Union.

The conditions that must be met to apply for student union membership:

- 1- The student must be Egyptian.
- 2- The student must be characterized by good morals and a good reputation.
- 3- He is a regular student who is a new student in his study group and does not remain for repetition
- 4- He must pay the tuition fees.
- 5- He is one of those with remarkable activity in the field of work of the committee in which he nominates himself.
- 6- He must not have been previously imposed criminal or disciplinary penalties.



Disciplinary punishments

Article (124):

Any violation of university laws, regulations and traditions is considered a disciplinary offense, in particular:

- 1- Acts that disrupt the college system or university facilities.
- 2- Disrupting the study, inciting it, or unjustified abstention

From attending lessons, lectures and other university work that the regulations require attendance

- 3- Any act that contradicts honor or dignity or violates good conduct inside or outside the university.
- 4- Any breach of the examination system or the necessary calm for it and any cheating in an examination or attempting to do so.
- 5- Any damage to facilities, equipment, materials and university books or wasting them
- 6- Any organization of groups within the university or participation in them without prior authorization from the competent university authorities.
- 7- Distributing leaflets or issuing newspapers in any form in colleges or collecting signatures without prior authorization from the competent university authorities.
- 8- Sit-in inside university buildings or participate in demonstrations that violate the public order or morality of students.

Article (125):

- 1- Every student who commits cheating in an exam or an attempt to do so and is caught in flagrante delicto, the dean or his representative shall remove him from the examination committee and shall be prohibited from entering the exam in the rest of the subjects, and the student shall be considered a failure in all subjects of this exam and referred to a disciplinary board.
- 2- In other cases, the exam is invalidated by a decision of the Disciplinary Board or the Faculty Council, and it results in the nullification of the degree if it was awarded to the student before the cheating was detected.

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Article (126) Disciplinary punishments are:

- 1- Verbal or written warning.
- 2- Warning.
- 3- Deprivation of some student services.
- 4- Deprivation from attending the lessons of a course for a period not exceeding one month.
- 5- Dismissal from the college for a period not exceeding one month.
- 6- Denial of examination in one or more courses.
- 7- Suspending the student's registration for a master's or doctoral degree for a period not exceeding a semester.
- 8- Cancellation of an exam in one or more courses.



9 - Dismissal from the college for a period not exceeding a semester.

10 - Deprivation of the exam in one or more semesters.

11- Depriving the student from registering for a master's or doctoral degree for a semester or more.

12- Dismissal from the college for a period not exceeding one semester.

13 - Final dismissal from the university and the decision of dismissal is communicated to all other universities and results in the student's ineligibility to enroll or take the exam in the universities of the Arab Republic of Egypt.

* It may be ordered to announce the decision issued by the disciplinary penalty within the college, and the decision must be communicated to the student's guardian.

* The decisions issued by the disciplinary penalty, except for the verbal warning, shall be kept in the student's file

* The University Council has the right to reconsider the decision issued by the final dismissal after at least three years have passed from the date of its issuance

Article (127)

The bodies competent to impose penalties:

1- Professors and assistant professors:

They may impose the first four penalties indicated in the previous article for what occurs from students during lessons, lectures and various activities.

2- Dean of the college:

- He is entitled to impose the first eight penalties from the previous article.

- In the event of a strike or a breach of order that is feared or causes the irregularity of the study or exams, the dean of the college may impose all the penalties indicated in the previous article, provided that the matter is presented within two weeks from the date of imposing the penalty and the decision of the disciplinary board if the decision is a final dismissal from the university to Mr. / President of the University.

3- University President:

He has the right to impose all the penalties indicated in the previous article, except the last penalty, after taking the opinion of the Dean of the Faculty, and he may prevent the student referred to the Disciplinary Board from entering the university until the day set for his trial.

4- Disciplinary Board: He has the right to impose all penalties

Article (129)

The decisions issued by the competent body to impose disciplinary penalties in accordance with Article (127) are final. However, the decision issued in absentia by the Disciplinary Board may be contested within a week from the date of its announcement to the student or guardian, and the decision is considered present if the request for attendance was announced to the person of the student or guardian and the student failed to attend without an acceptable excuse.

The student may appeal against the disciplinary decision as soon as he is informed of the decision, and the university president presents the grievances submitted to him to the University Council for consideration.

Satisfactory excuses and rules for accepting them

The rules for accepting sickness excuses submitted by students to apologize for studying and exams in the university colleges shall be as follows:



1- The Student Affairs Department in the college shall refer students who wish to fail to study or exams for a sick excuse to the university medical department, which presents them to the sickness excuses committee to determine whether or not to accept the request and inform the applicant of it.

2- If the student is exposed on the day of the exam to a sudden illness before the start of the exam and it results in his inability to enter the exam on college dates, he must go to the university hospital and obtain papers indicating the time of his arrival and departure from the hospital and present him to the medical committee.

3- If the student is exposed to a sudden illness during the performance of the exam that prevents him from completing the exam, the medical examination will be signed by the committee's doctor and write a report on his condition and approved by the head of the examination committee and transferred to the university hospital to present to the sickness excuses committee.

4- Urgent cases that have special circumstances are presented to the University Council for a decision after reviewing the opinion of the Faculty Council and the Medical Department, taking into account the opinion of the sickness excuse committee in the case, and the text of paragraphs (3 and 4) of Article (80) of the Executive Regulations of the University Organization Law is applied, which is: If a student fails to enter the exam with a compelling excuse accepted by the Faculty Council, his absence is not considered a failure, provided that his failure does not exceed two consecutive or separate opportunities during the years of study in the college, and in case of necessity a third opportunity may be granted by the University Council.

Tips for Students:

- *Be self-confident and rely on yourself while studying.
- *Create healthy conditions for yourself to study, such as a quiet, comfortable and tidy place, provided that it has enough light
- *Do not study when you are tired.
- *Organize your school supplies and provide everything you need without the need to borrow from others.
- * Make a study schedule and stick to it.
- *Increase your vocabulary and use the library.
- * Record the necessary and important notes and use them in studying.
- * Ask your teacher and your classmates inside and outside the amphitheater.
- *Do not be ashamed to admit ignorance and learn what is new by utilizing books, people, and everything around you.
- *Practice activities and hobbies that help and help success in study.
- *Accept exams as a goal and be calm and reassured when performing them.
