





Admission and Transfer Policy Document

The Faculty of Veterinary Medicine at Zagazig University follows the admission and transfer policies stipulated in the Egyptian Universities Organization Law and its executive regulation (Law) 49 of 1979 and the decisions of the Supreme Council of Universities in this regard.

1-Number of students accepted by the faculty annually

The Supreme Council of Universities determines at the end of each academic year, based on a proposal from the University Council after taking the opinion of the Faculty Council, the number of students who will be admitted to the Faculty of Veterinary Medicine at Zagazig University in the following year.

2-Those who are eligible to apply for the program

Holders of a high school diploma (science) from the Arab Republic of Egypt. Holders of an equivalent certificate for the Egyptian high school, scientific science division (expatriates).

3-How to apply for the program

3/1-For high school graduates from the Arab Republic of Egypt

1-The student withdraws and completes the form of his desires, whether by going to

the Student Coordination Office or through the office's website, which is:

2-After the coordination result appears and the student is nominated to join the college, the student goes to the college's student affairs office

With the following papers:-المحجمة والمحجم المرح والم

3-The student obtains a medical examination form and an application for enrollment in the college through the college's Student Affairs Office and authorization to pay the fees.

4-After completing the medical examination, the student must complete the enrollment application and pay the fees, the student submits all the papers he received before after filling them out with the data in addition to the receipts for payment of fees to the Student Affairs Office to become enrolled in the college.







3/2: For students who obtained their high school diploma from outside the Arab Republic of Egypt

1- The student applies to the General Administration for Expatriates of the Ministry of Higher Education.

Required papers to be submitted:

1-The high school diploma (the equivalent is approved and certified by the Embassy of the Arab Republic of Egypt in the country from which the student obtained the certificate or the embassy of the country from which the certificate was obtained in Cairo

2-For students who obtained the Egyptian high school diploma, they must submit the white form indicating Success.

-Original birth certificate or an official extract from it.

-(6) recent photographs.

-Fulfillment of the data of the following papers, which are found in an envelope obtained from the Embassy in Cairo and the Office of Arab Affairs

Arab affairs, namely:

A- Application for enrollment (Form 555 Coordination)

B-Initial nomination card.

c. Information form (four copies).

D -Guardian's declaration.

3-After the student is notified of his nomination to join the college, the student must go to the college's student affairs office to complete فسيحتجو الاوطليهم

The aforementioned application procedures.

4- Academic Fees

For Egyptian students

The student pays the prescribed fees in accordance with Article 271 of the Executive Regulations of the University Organization Law.

For international students whose father or mother non-Egyptian

In accordance with the decision of the President of the Arab Republic of Egypt No. 465 of 1990 amending some provisions of Article 271 of the Executive Regulations of the Universities Organization Law, international students pay 1500 pounds sterling as

a first-time registration fee and 1500 pounds sterling as annual tuition fees.

5. Study System







The study begins on the third Saturday of September and continues for thirty weeks, and the mid-year vacation is for two weeks according to the date determined by the University Council, and the duration of the study is five years distributed over ten semesters, after which the student obtains a bachelor's degree in veterinary medical sciences provided that he successfully passes the International Computer Driving License (ICDL) or the equivalent of other certificates and does not grant a bachelor's degree until after he performs the summer training and successfully passes the summer training exams.

6 –Transfers

First: Freshmen transfers

1-The student can transfer through the website for a specific period after being nominated to enroll in the college.

2- When the electronic transfer period specified by the Coordination Office expires, the

student can transfer by submitting transfer requests to the central student affairs office at the university.

With payment of fees.

Documents required for transfer:

A) Transfer application.

B) Nomination card.

c) Proof of residence in the governorate to which you want to transfer Second: - Transfers of students of higher teams (second, third and fourth) Transfer students can transfer to equivalent colleges in other universities according to the following conditions:

1 – The transfer between equivalent colleges in universities should be centralized at the level of each university.

2 - The student must be successful and transferred to a higher division in the transferred college.

3- The percentage of transfers does not exceed 20% of the number of students enrolled in the division to which the transfer is required.

4 - Priority for transfer among applicants should be given to students with the highest totals. E - It is not permissible to accept requests to transfer students between analogous colleges after one month after the start of the study. - The transfer must be to the nearest university to the student's place of residence, and there must be proof of residence, such as a rental contract, electricity, water, telephone, or gas receipt.) Taking into account the geographical distribution of students).







Transfer method : The student submits a transfer request with a status statement extracted from the college to the central student affairs office. Note : Final year students are not allowed to transfer.
